Where can you find yew trees?

- Britain is home to far more ancient yews than any other country in Europe. The <u>Ancient Yew Group</u> has identified 978 ancient or veteran yews (more than 500 years old) in England and 407 in Wales; France has 77; Germany and Spain just four each.
- "It's the tree of life, death and resurrection and it's known as the tree of life in all cultures across the northern hemisphere,"
- The tree's mystical qualities are derived from its ability to regenerate, producing fresh shoots from apparently "dead" wood such as the staffs of holy men or beams within buildings.
- The yew can regenerate us too the anti-cancer drug Taxol is derived from the bark of the Pacific yew - while the ancient trees are home to an as-yet unknown wealth of other life. From <u>Guardian Article about</u> <u>Yews</u>
